The Accreditation Commission of the American Association of Christian Schools (AACS) approved your school for full accreditation status on June 22, 2012 for a period of five years. The Commission's decision was based on the Accreditation Team's written report, the recommendation for accreditation by the on-site accreditation team, and the Accreditation Commission's evaluation of the team's accreditation report. The final stage to the accreditation sequence is *ongoing*, involving the maintenance of a quality program in the following ways:

- 1. Updating the School Improvement Plan (SIP) on an annual basis.
- 2. Filing an annual report with the office of the American Association of Christian Schools.
- 3. Preparing for the mid-accreditation consultative visit in fall 2014.
- 4. Renewing the accreditation sequence during the fifth year of the accreditation period.
- 5. Addressing the Accreditation Team's recommendations.

Please be advised that a school can lose accredited status for the following reasons:

- 1. Failure to renew accredited status after the period of accreditation has lapsed.
- 2. Failure to renew annual membership with AACS. Accredited status would cease on January 1 of the school year in which membership was not renewed.
- 3. Failure to submit the annual report and annual fee.
- 4. Failure to schedule a mid-accreditation visit.
